

Compliance Documentation Checklist

Mandatory Documents Needed

The following requirements are necessary to claim assets from accounts of deceased persons. The requested documents must contain the "Apostille" of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of your jurisdiction of residence to be processed. The "Apostille" of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs is required by the laws of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico and the Federal Regulations of the United States:
